**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR
SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (STBG) FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside is responsible for the condition and maintenance of all city streets and sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified the need to remove and replace the curb, gutter, and sidewalk along East Edison Avenue between 7th Street and 9th Street on the north side of the street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has already received a grant from the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) to redesign and replace these curbs, gutters, and sidewalks. The City wishes to seek additional funding to supplement this project to incorporate storm drainage, additional ADA upgrades, and install a brick paver band; and


WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to submit an application is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit an application to the Surface Transportation Block Grant funding to supplement our TIB Grant Project, for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
