

ORDINANCE 2020 - 07

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 2.50
OF THE SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE, PERTAINING TO CITIZEN
ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.13 RCW the City Council is charged with legislative authority of the City of Sunnyside; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.50 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code governs all citizen advisory boards and commissions, now existing or in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has requested a change to the time of their meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Section 2.50.100 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code should be amended to modify the time of the Planning Commission meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that modification of such schedule will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2.50.100 is amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. Except as amended herein, Title 2 SMC shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after passage, approval and publication as required by law.



Exhibit "A"

2.50.100 Planning Commission specific requirements.

A. Governing Law. The Planning Commission is created pursuant to Chapter [35A.63](#) RCW.

B. Membership. The Planning Commission shall consist of seven members. At least five members of the Planning Commission shall reside within the boundaries of the City or the City's Urban Growth Area (UGA), as now existing or hereafter altered, and up to two members may reside within any area within the boundaries of Sunnyside School District No. 201, as such now exist or are hereafter altered.

C. Meetings. The Planning Commission shall hold one regularly scheduled meeting each month at the hour of ~~6:30~~[5:30](#) p.m., on the second Tuesday of each and every month. The Planning Commission may meet at any other time as needed when called by the chairperson, majority of members thereof, or the City Council; provided, that any such special meeting shall be properly noticed in accordance with SMC [2.50.070](#). In the event any meeting date should be a legal holiday, then any such meeting falling on such holiday shall be held on the next succeeding business day at ~~6:30~~[5:30](#) p.m., unless otherwise specifically provided.

D. Duties and Responsibilities. The responsibility of the Planning Commission shall be to consider all amendments, modifications or alterations to the City's comprehensive plan, to conduct hearings as otherwise specified by law, to hear, review, and recommend proposed annexations of the City, and to perform other planning functions as required by the City Council and State law.
