**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING  
A 2% LOCAL ASSESSMENT INCREASE FOR THE  
YAKIMA VALLEY OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the Yakima Valley Office of Emergency Management's (YVOEM) mission includes having the plans in place to deal with major emergencies or a disaster; and

**WHEREAS**, YVOEM ensures the City of Sunnyside is compliant with the requirements set out in RCW and WAC and maintain systems to assist the City of Sunnyside if it were to become overwhelmed by unforeseen events either natural or manmade; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside supports a 2% increase for fiscal year 2013 in the overall local assessment to maintain a staff of three at the YVOEM; and



**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby supports the 2% (\$303) local assessment increase for fiscal year 2012 at the YVOEM.

**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon as required by law.


