## Proclamation

***WHEREAS**, on November 8, 1954, the Congress of the United States; recognizing the contributions of our service men and women, directed the President to proclaim the 11<sup>th</sup> day of November of each year as Veterans Day (5 U.S.C. 87a), and,*

***WHEREAS**, on this day, we wish to pay tribute to the nearly 30 million men and women whose serve or continue to serve in our Armed Forces, and,*

***WHEREAS**, we wish to recognize that no act of citizenship is more worthy of our respect than a willingness to serve in our armed forces and to protect and defend our nation's ideals.*

***NOW THEREFORE**, I, James A. Restucci, Mayor of the City of Sunnyside, Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Washington and on behalf of the City Council do hereby proclaim Monday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013, Veteran's Day in the City of Sunnyside.*

*I urge all citizens of our community to take part in ceremonies and events scheduled for this day, and especially encourage remembrance of those men and women who are sick and disabled and to those who are patients in our hospitals.*

*Furthermore, I call upon and direct the City Manager to lower the flags of the United States and Washington State at all city facilities pursuant to SMC 1.14.030.*
