**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS,
LOCAL #3542**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside and International Association of Fire Fighters, Local #3542 have previously entered into collective bargaining agreements; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a Memorandum of Understanding regarding FLSA straight time rate including incentives for time spent on facility ambulance transport and to affect the Battalion Chief; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that approval of such Memorandum of Understanding is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Memorandum of Understanding, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, by and between the City of Sunnyside and International Association of Fire Fighters Local #3542, is hereby approved; and the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to execute such Memorandum of Understanding for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BY AND BETWEEN
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON
AND
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS UNION LOCAL #3542
UNIFORMED SUPERVISORY PERSONNEL**

This agreement pertains to the use of members of this bargaining unit to staff inter facility ambulance transports while off duty.

A call for an inter facility ambulance transport for which an employee is requested to respond during non-duty hours shall be considered to be a minimum of one (1) hour. Each employee shall receive pay computed at the employee's FLSA straight time rate including incentive pays, for time spent on the inter facility ambulance transport. However, an employee responding as requested above and requested to handle a second or additional inter facility ambulance transport shall continue to receive the straight time rate, but shall not receive additional minimums for such subsequent transport(s) until released from service by the officer in charge. Effective the first day of the pay period after signature date.

It is understood that no other types of emergency calls, non emergency calls, training or inter facility ambulance transports during normal duty hours are covered by this agreement. All of these other events are considered to be a part of the employee's normal responsibilities and are compensated by the employee's normal salary.

This memorandum of understanding is on effect until the expiration of the current collective bargaining agreement, December 31, 2013. This memorandum of understanding only applies to the current members of the International Association of Firefighters local #3542 Uniformed Supervisory Personal bargaining unit.
