**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION FOR
Rural Development Community Facility Loan
(United States Department of Agriculture-USDA)**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that funding for Downtown Revitalization, 6th Street Improvements, both TIB Projects at the intersection of 16th /YVH and the Overlay Project, as well as the 11th & Kearney CDBG Projects are a high priority to promote the health, safety and welfare of residents of the City of Sunnyside; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate administration and award of a loan through the Rural Development Community Facility Loan(USDA) application process, it is necessary and appropriate to adopt a resolution authorizing and certifying availability of funds sufficient to meet the required loan obligation of such program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that an application by the City of Sunnyside for the USDA funds is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Sunnyside hereby certifies that sufficient funds are available through enterprise funds, to meet the USDA loan requirements and obligation term of 40 years at 3.5% interest; and that the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to sign and submit such application for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside and to expend such funds for such purposes in the event of an award of this loan.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


