1. ACTIVE AGENDA:

A. Recreation Program DiscussioN

- Kari met with Frank to discuss Edgar(SS Promise BBall director). Promise is trying to facilitate Edgar's roll as director of Baseball program and she has an issue with this.
- T-ball conflicting with Cal Ripken schedule. Kari requested their schedule. June1 to July 31 has been scheduled for T-ball.
 - Need to have this for underprivileged children
 - T-ball at south hill park for 2 months
 - Keep fields at south hill park to prevent parents from running back and forth between different games.
 - Will also prevent volunteers from running back and forth between facilities.
 - T-ball games are on staurday, may not even conflict with other baseball program.
- Bring number and Edgars pay to council and cut out the middle man(lisa) for Edgar. Most responsibility is on Edgar...promise not really doing their part.
 - Will help financially
 - Katrina at the community center is helping Edgar, but is not allowed to do so.
- Need account info for soccer and b-ball programs along for future programs because nothing has been presented back to the council.
 - Get all the info together
 - Where is the money? Money is not being paid back to program.
 - Maybe "up" Edgar's pay to retain him. May be able to achieve this by eliminating promise.

B. Park Facilities Update-

- Sunnyview Park- Opens in May
 - Sprinkler are having issues. Staff is working to fix them. Getting foul poles for softball fields. Pouring concrete this Friday.
 - One team has already signed up for soccer(kids)
 - No Vendors allowed, if so, PD will be called
 - No soccer league on Wednesday or Sunday
 - Sunnyview not open to soccer yet because grass is too fragile this time of year
 - No need to hire sprayers for grass at sunnyview
 - All parks except sunnyview will get new signs
 - Sunnyview already has a park sign
- Swimming Pool- Open in mid May
 - Getting passes for volunteers of programs for free day of swimming.
 - Getting a lift for the people in wheel chairs for the pool.
