Proclamation

WHEREAS, On November 3, 1964 voters in and around the City of Sunnyside voted to approve and form the Port of Sunnyside by a vote of 2022 to 1840, and;

WHEREAS, On November 27, 1964, the Yakima County Board of County Commissioners met to certify the election returns and officially declared the Port of Sunnyside as "...hereby formed as a municipal corporation of the State of Washington.", and;

WHEREAS, on that same day, the Honorable William S. Barnard, the Honorable Richard Golob and the Honorable Van E. Nutley were elected to serve as the first Port Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, I, James A. Restucci, Mayor of the City of Sunnyside, Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Washington and on behalf of the City Council do hereby proclaim today, Thursday, July 17, 2014 as **Port of Sunnyside Day** in the City of Sunnyside.

On behalf of the citizens of Sunnyside, the Council and I wish to congratulate the Port of Sunnyside on its 50th Anniversary and we look forward to their future success and our continued relationship.
