**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING
AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION SERVICES
WITH TRI-VALLEY CONSTRUCTION, INC.
(Fire Station Alley Manhole Replacement)**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside owns, operates, and maintains the Waste Water Treatment Plant and all associated sewer collection infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, on July 19, 2013 the City was made aware of a failing manhole structure and piping located on the west side of the Sunnyside Fire Station at 513 S. 8th Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside solicited phone bids to have the manhole and associated piping replaced; and

WHEREAS, Tri-Valley Construction, Inc. was the low bidder with a price of \$9,400.00, not including applicable state taxes; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that approval of such agreement is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Sunnyside City Council hereby accepts the bid to remove and replace the manhole in the alley on the west side of the Sunnyside Fire Station as set forth in the quote attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute such purchase for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside and to take all actions reasonable and necessary to administer performance of such purchase.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon as required by law.

Pricing based on no-dewatering or unsuitable soils.


