**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING  
AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CHANGE ORDER #2 FOR  
SUNNYSIDE FIRE STATION ADDITION/RENOVATION PROJECT  
(Blew's Construction, Inc.)**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has previously awarded a bid for the Sunnyside Fire Station project to Blew's Construction, Inc; and

**WHEREAS**, Blew's Construction, Inc., has submitted additional costs for the discovery of slabs of concrete buried in two areas of where the new fire station footings were to be formed and poured. These buried slabs of concrete were discovered during the demolition and site preparation phase of construction. Area number one was found in the area of the new dorm rooms and area number two was under the new apparatus bay floor. This debris was required to be removed and over excavated to be suitable to be build on in accordance with engineering standards; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that acceptance of Change Order #2 in the amount of \$32,441.86, and authorizing the execution of an agreement is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**Section 1.** That the Change Order #2 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, in the amount of \$32,441.86, including applicable taxes, submitted by Blew's Construction Inc., for the Fire Station Addition/Renovation Project, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare, execute and administer an agreement with such company for the changes submitted for such project on file with the City of Sunnyside.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


