**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP)
FUNDING OF NON-MOTORIZED PROJECTS
(N. 16th Street Sidewalk Project)**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside was notified of a regional call for projects via Yakima Valley Conference of Governments (YVCOG) for Transportation Alternative Programs (TAP) which provides flexible funding that may be used for projects related to non-motorized transportation projects; and

WHEREAS, City staff has identified a project on N. 16th Street that would connect a section of sidewalk and provide a safer route to the schools located at the North City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that an application by the City of Sunnyside for the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant funds is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign and submit the Transportation Alternatives Program application, for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside for funding to install 350' of curb and gutter and 750' of sidewalk on N. 16th Street.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
