**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING
BID FOR ONE NEW TYPE III MODULAR AMBULANCE
FROM LIFELINE EMERGENCY VEHICLES, SUMNER, IA**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously solicited sealed bids for purchase of one (1) new type III modular ambulance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has received one responsive bid from a responsible bidder, Lifeline Emergency Vehicles, in the amount of \$143,316.00 plus Washington State sales tax in the amount of \$11,312.97, for a total cost of \$154,637.97; and

WHEREAS, the design and quality of ambulances built by Lifeline Emergency Vehicles in Sumner, Iowa matches the current ambulance fleet and will provide a forth ambulance unit; and

WHEREAS, this additional new unit will enable the fire department to have one (1) reserve ambulance in the fleet; and

WHEREAS, a reserve ambulance will be necessary when the department begins the process of replacing ambulance chassis through a remounting process in the upcoming years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the acceptance of the bid for one new type III modular ambulance is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety, and welfare of residents of the City of Sunnyside.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. That the bid submitted by Life Line Emergency Vehicles, Sumner, Iowa, for one new type III modular ambulance is hereby accepted and authorized, in the total amount of \$154,637.97, including all applicable taxes and charges, such purchase being justified through the state bidding process.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents deemed necessary and appropriate to accomplish such purchase, all in accordance plans and specifications on file with the City of Sunnyside.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval, and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
