**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,  
REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR A NEW  
100 FOOT AERIAL PLATFORM FOR USE  
BY THE SUNNYSIDE FIRE DEPARTMENT**



**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside has previously authorized the solicitation of sealed bids for the acquisition of a new 100 ft. aerial platform ladder; and

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids have been received and considered by the City of Sunnyside on August 20, 2014, and reviewed by the Sunnyside Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the bids submitted by Rosenbauer and Smeal Fire Apparatus Co. were not responsive to the bid requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, KME's bid was responsive to the bid specifications but not within the City's funds available for the purchase of this specific piece of apparatus; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the rejection of such bids is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside, and will promote the general health and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the bids submitted by Rosenbauer, Smeal Fire Apparatus Company, and KME all be rejected for reasons stated above.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
