



**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH CASCADE FIRE
AND EQUIPMENT, INC, YAKIMA, WA, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 102' KME AERIAL
LADDER PLATFORM**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously approved an inter-local agreement with Houston-Galveston Area Council, hereinafter referred to as "H-GAC, for cooperative purchasing; and

WHEREAS, Cascade Fire Equipment Inc. is the authorized west coast dealer for Kovatch Mobile Equipment Corp, hereinafter referred to as "KME" located in Nesquehoning, PA; and

WHEREAS, Sunnyside Fire Department has chosen KME as the manufacturer of a 102' ladder platform because KME best meets the specifications designed and listed in the apparatus specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside will contract with Cascade Fire Equipment for the purchase of the 102' ladder platform in the amount of \$911,820.00 not including Washington State sales tax; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the contract with Cascade Fire Equipment for the purchase of a 102' KME ladder platform is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety, and welfare of residents of the City of Sunnyside.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**


Section 1. That the contract with Cascade Fire Equipment, Yakima, WA for a 102' KME ladder platform is hereby accepted and authorized, in the amount of \$911,820, plus Washington State taxes in the amount of \$74,769.00, for a total of

\$986,589.24 with such purchase being justified through the Inter-local Contract for Cooperative Purchasing with H-GAC.

Section 2. The City manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents deemed necessary and appropriate to accomplish such purchase, all in accordance plans and specifications on file with the City of Sunnyside.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval, and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
