

ORDINANCE 2014 - 15

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING TITLE 2
OF THE SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING
TO CITIZEN ADVISORY BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS**



WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.13 of the Revised Code of Washington, the City Council is charged with the legislative authority of the City of Sunnyside; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.50 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code governs all citizen advisory boards and commissions, now existing or in the future; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that chapter 2.50 should be amended to address concerns regarding membership of the Sunnyside Arts Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that adoption of these amendments is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2.50.150(B) of the Sunnyside Municipal Code, which reads as follows:

B. Membership. The Sunnyside Arts Commission shall consist of nine members who shall serve terms provided in SMC 2.50.040; three members shall be citizens-at-large and shall have no vested interest in any particular art or cultural endeavor; three members shall be from the following classes of individuals: artist, musician, or actor; two members shall be Sunnyside Fine Arts teachers; and one member shall be a member of the City Council.

First Reading: November 10, 2014

Second Reading: November 24, 2014

Is amended to read as follows:

2.50.150(B) Membership. The Sunnyside Arts Commission shall consist of nine members who shall serve terms provided in SMC 2.50.040; three members shall be citizens-at-large and shall have no vested interest in any particular art or cultural endeavor; three members shall be from the following classes of individuals: artist, musician, or actor; one member shall be a Sunnyside Fine Arts teacher; one member shall be a youth representative (student) from a Sunnyside area high school; and one member shall be a member of the City Council.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Title 2 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective five days after passage, approval and publication as required by law.
