



**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING
CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS TO THE USES AND NEEDS OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside owns and operates various pieces of equipment and vehicles as part of the fleet; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside would like to surplus two (2) police cruisers that are no longer drivable; and

WHEREAS, staff is working with a local auction company to surplus these vehicles at a public auction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the two (2) police cruisers are no longer of viable uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside, and should be declared surplus, with disposition authorized by any means deemed appropriate under state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that such declaration and disposition of property is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the two (2) police cruisers are hereby declared to be surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of such equipment by any means allowable pursuant to state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


