**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
A TASK ORDER TO PREPARE APPLICATION
FOR A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)
WITH HUIBREGTSE LOUMAN, ASSOC.
FOR 11TH STREET AND KEARNEY PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside operates and maintains all water and sewer infrastructure within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, city staff has identified a serious deficiency within its water system to supply adequate fire flow capacity in the area of 11th Street & Kearney Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a task order with HLA to start the preparation of the application to CDBG for funding to remove and replace all deficient water mains along 11th Street and Kearney Avenue; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that such approval is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Sunnyside City Council hereby approves the Task Order 2015-4 with Huibregtse Louman, Associates to prepare the application to CDBG as set forth in the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute such agreement for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside and to take all actions reasonable and necessary to administer performance of such agreement.


SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.

EXHIBIT "A"

- D. Obtain approval of all governmental authorities having jurisdiction over the PROJECT, and approvals and consents from other individuals or bodies as may be necessary for completion of the PROJECT.

TIME OF PERFORMANCE:

All work will be diligently pursued and coordinated with the CITY for submittal of the application by the June 1, 2015, deadline. Engineering Design, Bidding and Construction services will follow when design and construction funding is available.

FEE FOR SERVICES:

For the services furnished by HLA as described under this Agreement, the CITY agrees to pay HLA the fees as set forth herein. The amounts listed below may be revised only by written agreement of both parties.

TASK 1 – FUNDING APPLICATION

All work for this phase shall be performed on an hourly basis in accordance with Exhibit A – Schedule of Hourly Rates attached to the General Services Agreement, for an estimated maximum amount of \$10,000.00.

Additional Services

Any additional work requested by the CITY shall be performed on a time-spent basis in accordance with Exhibit A - Schedule of Hourly Rates attached to the General Services Agreement, plus reimbursement for direct non salary expenses, reproduction expenses, and travel costs.
