ORDINANCE 2011 - 15

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING
SITES FOR DISPLAY OF THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES
OF AMERICA WITHIN THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside has determined that the City should designate specified locations for the display of the United States flag by the City of Sunnyside within its city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside has determined that four locations should be designated for display of the United States flag by the City of Sunnyside; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The following locations are hereby designated as official sites for display of the flag of the United States of America by the City of Sunnyside:

- City Hall
- Police Department
- Fire Department
- Centennial Square

Section 2. The City of Sunnyside may from time to time and consistent with Title 4, United States Code display a United States flag at other locations within the City of Sunnyside when appropriate and necessary to do so.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective five days after passage, approval and publication as required by law.
