

RESOLUTION 2011 - 08

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE  
AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A CRIME ANALYST POSITION,  
FIXING THE SALARY FOR THE POSITION AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER  
TO PROVIDE FOR THE NECESSARY BUDGET MODIFICATIONS REQUIRED  
FOR FUNDING OF THE CRIME ANALYST POSITION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside desires to provide the Sunnyside Police Department with the resources necessary to make the City of Sunnyside a safe place to live, work and play; and

**WHEREAS**, the creation of a Crime Analyst position would allow the Police Department to more efficiently deploy police resources through a more systematic identification and analysis of patterns and trends in crime and disorder.; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has identified resources that will pay for the initial start-up and on-going expenses of the position;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** The Sunnyside City Council authorizes the creation of a full time position of Crime Analyst with benefits and a monthly salary range as shown below for inclusion in the 2011-2012 biennial budget.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is authorized to immediately begin the recruitment and selection process to allow for the hiring of a Crime Analyst in an expeditious manner as possible.

**SECTION 3.** The position of Crime Analyst shall be eligible for all employee benefits provided for non-represented employees in Ordinance No. 2088 or as they may be modified in the future by the City Council.

**SECTION 4.** The City Manager shall provide for the necessary budget modifications to be included in the next budget amendment to be brought to Council for consideration with funding for the Crime Analyst position and its

related costs to be provided by the \$100,000 in non-budget revenue to be received from the liquor profits and liquor excise tax distribution as a result of the failure of Initiatives I-1000 and I-1105.
