**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, CERTIFYING
PERFORMANCE AND COMPLIANCE WITH PROVISIONS
AND REQUIREMENTS OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT FOR CITY OF SUNNYSIDE HOUSING
ENHANCEMENT PROJECT
("New Life Homes Sunnyside")**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside was awarded and received funds in the amount of \$258,909.00 administered through the Community Development Block Grant Program of the State of Washington Department of Commerce, for use in construction of offsite water, sewer and street improvements in support of a Housing Enhancement Project developed by the Diocese of Yakima at and upon property located near the intersection of McClain Avenue and Beckner Alley; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with such grant application and award, the City of Sunnyside has previously certified compliance with the conditions and requirements of such grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has held a public hearing on February 28, 2011, pursuant to notice duly published, and pursuant to requirements of the grant, to receive evidence and testimony regarding compliance with the terms and conditions of such grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, having considered the files and records herein and all evidence and testimony presented at such public hearing, finds and determines that all requirements of such grant, including performance and reporting requirements, have been met, and the project is deemed fully constructed and performed in compliance with the terms and conditions of such grant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that all requirements and performance required pursuant to such grant and the provisions of the prior certification have been met and satisfied.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby certifies performance and compliance with the provisions, terms and conditions of the Community Development Block Grant allocated and awarded such Housing Enhancement Project; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to communicate this Resolution and the certification

approved herein to the appropriate agencies of the State of Washington and other agencies with jurisdiction.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
