RESOLUTION 2011 - 81

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE FOR PRESENTATION
TO THE COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL EXTENSIONS OF AGREEMENTS WITH
SUNNYSIDE'S PROMISE**

WHEREAS, by Partnership Agreement dated February 22, 2010 (hereinafter "Partnership Agreement"), the City of Sunnyside (hereinafter "City") entered into a Partnership Agreement for Sunnyside's Promise (hereinafter "Promise") to manage, operate and maintain the City's Community Center (hereinafter "Community Center"), as a community facility in order to meet the social, cultural, educational and recreational needs and desires of members of the public, all in accordance with the provisions, terms and conditions of the Partnership Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Community Center managed and operated by Promise provides social, cultural, educational and recreational programs for residents of the City, including but not limited to, youth activities in a safe place for youth after school and in the evenings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on April 11, 2011, by Resolution 2011-24, authorized the City Manager to sign an amendment of the Partnership Agreement with Promise modifying the Partnership Agreement and specifically providing Thirty-six Thousand Ninety-two and 97/100 Dollars (\$36,092.97) of funding during calendar year 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on March 28, 2011, by Resolution No. 2011-15, approved an Agreement for the City to provide Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) in funds to Promise for the purpose of Promise continuing its youth programs and for grant writing to obtain additional grants and to procure additional funding sources to continue

and expand Promise's youth programs within the City (hereinafter "Youth Programs Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, at the City Council's workshop on December 5, 2011, Promise presented requests for extension of funding in the amount of Fifty-one Thousand Seven Hundred and 97/100 Dollars (\$51,700.97) for operation of the Community Center, extension of funding of Fifty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$50,000.00) for Promise's youth programs and for grant writing to obtain additional grants and to procure additional funding to continue and expand Promise's youth programs within the City, and an additional Thirty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$30,000.00) to provide funding for Promise to provide parks and recreational style programming within the City; and

WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Community Center by Promise, continuation of youth programs by Promise and adding parks and recreational style programming within the City are in the best interest of the City and the health, safety and welfare of the City's residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to prepare for presentation to the Council for approval extensions or amendments of the Partnership Agreement and Youth Programs Agreement to provide Fifty-one Thousand Seven Hundred and 97/100 Dollars (\$51,700.97) for operation of the Community Center in 2012, Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to continue youth programs by Promise in 2012, and Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) for Promise to provide parks and recreational style programming within the City in 2012.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


