RESOLUTION 2012 - 18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
AND CERTIFYING AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL
MATCH REQUIREMENTS PURSUANT TO GRANT AND
SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION FOR
DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION IMPROVEMENTS - PHASE I
(Surface Transportation Program (STP)
Regional Competitive Application – (Design-only Grant))**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that funding for Downtown Revitalization Improvements is a high priority to promote the health, safety and welfare of residents of the City of Sunnyside; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate administration and award of grant funds through the STP Regional Competitive Application, it is necessary and appropriate to adopt a resolution authorizing and certifying availability of funds sufficient to meet the required local match of such grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that an application by the City of Sunnyside for the STP Regional Competitive grant funds is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:**

SECTION 1. That the City of Sunnyside hereby certifies that sufficient funds are available through appropriate funds of the city, including but not limited to other grant funds available for such purposes, to meet the local matching fund requirements of the Surface Transportation Program grant available through the Washington State Department of Transportation for the Downtown Improvement Project – Phase I; and that the City Manager is hereby authorized to sign and submit such application for and on behalf

of the City of Sunnyside and to expend such funds for such purposes in the event of an award of grant funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
