**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE
ACQUISITION OF FIVE VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside Police Department provides emergency response and investigative services within the incorporated city limits, and the immediate surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, in support of these responsibilities, the City of Sunnyside maintains a fleet of vehicles that, in the normal course of business, requires upgrading for purposes of safety, effectiveness, and to fit the Department's needs, and:

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of General Administration solicited bids for vehicles on behalf of the State of Washington and participating cities, counties and special purpose districts that meet the Department's needs, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that purchasing the necessary police vehicles through the bids solicited by the Washington State Department of General Administration will promote the general health, safety, and welfare, and:

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign the necessary contracts and/or agreements to procure five (5) appropriately equipped police sedans five (5) Dodge Chargers, from Karmart Automotive Group (W28688) of Burlington, WA, in the amount of \$250,446.50.

Section 2. Initial source of funding for four (4) vehicles shall be from the General Fund Un-appropriated Fund Balance to pay for the costs of the

lease and annual maintenance and operation costs for the remainder of 2011-2012 biennium.

Section 3. Initial source of funding for the one (1) vehicle for the vehicle designated for the "Gang Unit" shall be from the Investigative Fund (Fund 120) to pay for the costs of the lease and annual maintenance and operation costs for the remainder of 2011-2012 biennium.

Section 4. The Deputy City Manager/Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to secure adequate capital funding for the acquisition from the State of Washington LOCAL (Local Option Capital Asset Lending), bank or other appropriate financial institution subject to approval by the Sunnyside City Council.

Section 5. This resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval, and signatures hereon, in accordance with law.
