RESOLUTION 2011 - 39

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE
ACQUISITION OF A STREET SWEEPER FOR USE BY THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside Public Works Department provides street cleaning services within the incorporated city limits; and

WHEREAS, staff has previously identified the 2006 Elgin Crosswind Street Sweeper to be replaced during the 2011-2012 budget workshops, and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has solicited bids in accordance with the law for the acquisition of a street sweeper, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that acceptance of such bid and acquisition of such equipment is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety, and welfare, and:


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign the necessary contracts and/or agreements to procure one (1) appropriately equipped street sweeper, from Sahlberg Equipment Company of Buckley, WA, in the amount of \$141,656.67 which includes applicable taxes and trade-in value.

Section 2. Initial source of funding for the street sweeper shall be through use of a portion of the Stormwater Grant and an internal loan from the Water or Sewer Reserve Funds until long-term financing has been acquired. At that time the internal loan will be re-paid to the respective fund(s). The long-term funding will be allocated from both the Street and Stormwater Funds.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval, and signatures hereon, in accordance with law.


