RESOLUTION 2011 - 40

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE,
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO THE SOCIAL SECURITY
ADMINISTRATION AND INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE FOR 2008 AND 2009
CORRECTIONS TO FORM 941 AND EMPLOYEE W-2 REPORTS**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has determined that payroll errors were made with the respect to wages reported to the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and Social Security Administration (SS) associated with AFLAC programs participated in by City employees for 2009 and with the respect to the amount of wages subject to SS and Medicare taxes for 2008 and 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has determined the amounts due and payable to the IRS and SS with the respect to these payroll errors and that the City has the legal obligation to remit these amounts to the IRS and SS; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that payment of these amounts to the IRS and SS and reasonable efforts to collect the employee's proportion of SS and Medicare taxes and IRS withholding paid by the City with respect to these errors are in the best interest of the City;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

SECTION 1. That the Sunnyside City Council hereby approves and authorizes payment to SS in the amount of \$12,505 and payment to the IRS in the amount of \$1,684; and further authorizes and directs the Deputy City Manager/Chief Financial Officer to file all forms reasonable and necessary with the IRS and SS to correct the payroll errors related to these payments.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager is authorized and directed to take reasonable measures to collect those portions of these payments that were payable by current and former employees of the City and to report to the City Council on the status of these efforts.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon and in accordance with law.
