**RESOLUTION 2011 - 59**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING  
THE ACQUISITION OF TYLER CASHIERING MODULE FOR  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside utilizes Eden Systems' Core Cashiering software for all cashiering activities of the City related to utility billing, parks & recreation, building permits, business licensing and police; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has reviewed other options to reduce annual operating costs and to provide enhanced flexibility for the City of Sunnyside; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has identified a companion technology system from Tyler Technologies, owner of Eden Systems, that will allow the City to save thousands of dollars in out-year operating expenses and to obtain a positive rate of return in just over one year; and

**WHEREAS**, Tyler Technologies, as owner of the City's current Eden Systems' Core Cashiering software, is the single source for the compatible Tyler Cashiering module;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside authorizes the City Manager to sign the necessary documents and agreements to acquire and implement the Tyler Cashiering module for the City of

Sunnyside at a cost not to exceed \$23,000 from Eden Systems/Tyler Technologies.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for the acquisition and implementation of the Tyler Cashiering module shall come from the Information Technology fund.

This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


