**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING THE
IMPLEMENTATION OF A "GANG CRIME" DETECTIVE ASSIGNMENT
AS A PART OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside is in the process of restructuring the police department organizational chart in an effort to become more efficient and effective; and

WHEREAS, a component of that restructuring is the assigning of an officer to supplement the detective division upon the Department achieving certain goals, tasks, and objectives; and

WHEREAS, those goals have been met in substance and form, to include: improved case management systems be in place, all other officers having completed training to the point where they are able to solo-patrol, caseloads be assigned and managed in a manner that the patrol division realizes in practice a measurable level of an FTE due to detective efficiencies, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that such reorganization is in the best interest of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council supports the requested reorganization of the detective division (as above described, and illustrated on the attached organizational chart – Attachment "B").

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
