**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, RENEWING COMMITTEMENT OF
SUPPORTING THE ELIMINATION OF STREET GANGS IN SUNNYSIDE AND
SURROUNDING COMMUNITIES AND SUPPORTING THE VISION OF MAKING
SUNNYSIDE THE SAFEST COMMUNITY IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON**

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2011, the Sunnyside City Council approved Resolution 2011-30 in support of the elimination of street gangs and the vision of making Sunnyside the safest community in the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to renew that commitment and express their full confidence in the Sunnyside Police Department, its leadership, and the City Manager in implementing the Gang Elimination Strategy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the renewing the commitment of support of criminal street gang elimination efforts by the Sunnyside Police Department is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby renews its commitment in supporting the criminal street gang elimination efforts of the Sunnyside Police Department.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
