**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT SUPPLEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY
PACIFIC GROUNDWATER GROUP**

**(Unforeseen Engineering Services – Feasibility Determination for Location of
Hypochlorite Generation Facility at City Shops)**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has an existing contract with the Pacific Groundwater Group for development of its domestic water supply to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside requested that Pacific Groundwater Group, working with subconsultant HDR Engineering, Inc., perform additional work to develop an evaluation of architectural, structural, process, and mechanical components of the existing City Shops Building for the purpose of considering the building for retrofits, conversion and use as the Hypochlorite Generation Building; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside requested that Pacific Groundwater Group, working with subconsultant HDR Engineering, Inc., complete and provide an evaluation and report to the City staff prior to moving forward with developing final plans, specifications and bid documents for locating the Hypochlorite Generation Facility on the Monson Property as detailed in consultant's original scope of services; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Groundwater Group is recommending that the City Council approve this supplemental that will result in an increase to their contract and allow them to increase their sub consultant contract with HDR Engineering, Inc., as explained by staff from both firms at the March 5, 2012 council workshop - to address the out of scope feasibility services that were required by the City staff and provided by the Pacific Groundwater Group and HDR Engineering, Inc.;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF

THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside authorizes the City Manager to execute a supplement for unforeseen engineering services – feasibility determination for location of Hypochlorite Generation Facility at City Shops in an amount not to exceed \$2,008.05 to Pacific Groundwater Group, which includes the portion to be assigned to HDR Engineering, Inc., and as documented in the contract supplement attached as Exhibit “A” to this resolution.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
