**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING
CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS TO THE USES AND NEEDS OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside owns a street sweeper which is not compatible with the type of streets within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside would like to surplus the street sweeper; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on June 25, 2012 pursuant to SMC 3.12.010 (B)(1) to determine and consider such proposed action to surplus such property; and

WHEREAS, staff is working with the City of Kennewick to purchase the street sweeper from the City of Sunnyside; and

WHEREAS, if the City of Kennewick is unable to purchase the street sweeper, staff would like to dispose of by listing with State and Local Agency websites ; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the street sweeper purchased in 2012 is surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside, and should be declared surplus, with disposition authorized by any means deemed appropriate under state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that such declaration and disposition of property is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the 2012 Johnston Street Sweeper is hereby declared to be surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. The Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of such equipment by any means allowable pursuant to state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
