

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
by and between
CITY OF GRANDVIEW
and
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE**

TYPE OF ACTIVITY: 100 Block of Grandridge and West Fifth Street (Division to Grandridge)

EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL PROVIDED BY: CITY OF SUNNYSIDE

SERVICE PROVIDED TO: CITY OF GRANDVIEW (DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS)

TIME AND RATE: Not to exceed \$5,068.40 (\$506.84/hour rate based upon one shift of 10 hours)

LOCATION THAT EQUIPMENT WILL BE USED: CITY OF GRANDVIEW

PROJECT STARTING DATE: On or about July 26, 2012

PROJECT END DATE: On or about July 26, 2012

PAYMENT PERIOD: Payment for all services shall begin at the start of the regularly scheduled shift on the day of use. Payment period shall end upon completion of chip sealing activity for the day of use. No payment will be charged for lunch and break periods.

APPLICATION OF RATES: Rental rates and personnel costs are calculated by the hour only and shall not exceed 10 hours. All payments are within 30 calendar days of the services performed.

TRANSPORTATION: City of Sunnyside staff shall be responsible for the transportation of all equipment with the exception of the pneumatic roller. The City of Grandview shall be responsible to transport the pneumatic roller to and from the project site.

PROPERTY DAMAGE: During the performance of the chip sealing operations, any damage caused to private property during actual operations shall be the responsibility of the City of Grandview.

INSURANCE and LIABILITY: Each City agrees insure their respective staffs and equipment used during the project with the exception stated above for property damages

LIMITATION OF USE: The agreed project activity and payment is only for the use of the specified project and shall not exceed a single shift of 10 hours, unless otherwise amended prior to starting any new use.

OPERATORS AND FUEL: All equipment used by the City of Sunnyside during the performance of the activities stated within this agreement shall only be operated by City of

Sunnyside staff. The city of Grandview shall be responsible for the cost of all fuel used in the supplied equipment during the project.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON,
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
WITH THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE FOR THE GRANDRIDGE AND WEST FIFTH
STREET CHIP SEALING PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside and City of Grandview are authorized to enter into interlocal agreements for provision of equipment and services to benefit each agency per City of Grandview Resolution No. 2009-5 (Interlocal Master Agreement); and

WHEREAS, City of Grandview desires to have the City of Sunnyside Street Division perform roadway chip sealing operations on the 100 block of Grandridge and West Fifth Street from Division to Grandridge within the City of Grandview and the City of Sunnyside has such personnel and equipment available for such use; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated an Interlocal Agreement concerning the lease of such equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Grandview finds and determines that approval of such Interlocal Agreement is in the best interests of residents of the City of Grandview and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON, as follows:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the Interlocal Agreement by and between the City of Sunnyside and City of Grandview for the 100 block of Grandridge and West Fifth Street from Division to Grandridge chip sealing project in the form as is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.


