

RESOLUTION 2012 - 57

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING  
ITEMS TO BE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING  
DISPOSITION THEREOF**



**WHEREAS**, the Information Technology Division of the City of Sunnyside has replaced computer equipment and related information technology equipment, and as a result, has several items of such equipment that are surplus to the uses and needs of the division and the City of Sunnyside; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Sunnyside finds and determines that the property listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, and as hereafter described, is surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside and should be disposed of in accordance with law, including but not limited to, transfer of any such equipment to the Sunnyside School District, as determined appropriate by the Interim City Manager; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that such actions as authorized herein are in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON**, as follows:

**Section 1.** That the property listed and described in Exhibit "A" is hereby declared surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside; and the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of such surplus property in any manner deemed lawful and in the best interests of the City of Sunnyside, including but not limited to, transfer to the Sunnyside School District, or other appropriate disposition.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
