**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE
TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SOUTH HILL ROAD**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside operates and maintains public right of way, as well as traffic control revisions and modifications as it sees necessary; and

WHEREAS, upon request of the citizens of the City of Sunnyside a traffic count has been conducted and it has been determined that it would be in the interest of public safety and health to temporarily close South Hill Road for a one-year demonstration period, to help prevent speeding, negligent and reckless driving, and other traffic infractions along the street, and to inhibit criminal behavior along these streets in recent years; and


WHEREAS, notice of the proposed closure will be published and posted as required by RCW 47.48.020; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the temporary closure of South Hill Road is hereby closed for a one-year period, from August 1, 2012 through July 31, 2013, and the Interim City Manager is hereby authorized to direct city staff to implement this temporary closure.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
