

RESOLUTION 2012 - 104

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING
BID AND AUTHORIZING CONTRACT
WITH KNOBEL'S ELECTRIC, INC.
(LINCOLN AVENUE and SIXTH STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL)**



WHEREAS, the intersection of Lincoln Avenue and Sixth Street has a high volume of traffic; and

WHEREAS, to ease the flow of traffic in this area, Huibregtse Louman Associates, Inc., on behalf of the City of Sunnyside, has solicited bids for the modification of the traffic signal located in such area, in compliance with applicable law and procedure; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid submitted by a qualified bidder is in the lump sum amount of \$6,958.00, including taxes, from Knobel's Electric Inc., of Yakima, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that acceptance of such bid and authorizing the Interim City Manager to prepare and execute an agreement with Knobel's Electric, Inc. for the construction of the Project is in the best interests of residents of the City and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the bid in the amount of \$6,958.00, including taxes, submitted by Knobel's Electric, Inc. for the work of the Lincoln Avenue and Sixth Street Traffic Signal Project, is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare, execute and administer an agreement for the construction of such work, all in accordance with plans and specifications for such project.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.


