## **RESOLUTION 2016 - 20**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING BID AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY FOR THE 16<sup>TH</sup> STREET STORMWATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT



WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has solicited sealed bids for the construction of the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Stormwater System Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2016 at 2:00pm, the City of Sunnyside held a bid opening at the Sunnyside Fire Station and received (7) sealed bids. The lowest responsive bidder was Granite Construction Company with a bid of \$896,793.05; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines the bid from Granite Construction Company to be acceptable, and authorize the City Manager to act on behalf of the City of Sunnyside and to take all actions reasonable and necessary to administer these funds with full contractual authority, and is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Council accepts the bid from Granite Construction Company, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreement for the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Sidewalk Improvement Project, and act on behalf of the City of Sunnyside and to take all actions reasonable and necessary to administer these funds with full contractual authority.

**SECTION 2**. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
