

RESOLUTION 2018 - 18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH  
PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT AND THE WASHINGTON STATE  
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT BOARD FOR  
GRANT FUNDING TO REPLACE STREETLIGHTING**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside currently has an agreement with Pacific Power and Light (PP&L) to maintain 810 streetlights. This agreement includes all annual maintenance, repairs, and power costs in the amount of \$212,500.00 (2018); and

**WHEREAS**, PP&L has partnered with the Washington State Department of Transportation, more specifically the Transportation Improvement Board to create a program to replace high-pressure sodium, metal-halide, and mercury vapor lighting with LED lighting.

**WHEREAS**, the total cost to replace 810 streetlights is approximately \$282,645.38. Of that cost, \$24,381.95 will be remitted to the city from PP&L as part of their incentive program. The remaining cost of approximately \$258,263.43 will be paid for through a grant from the Transportation Improvement Board with no match requirement from the city. PP&L has determined that the city will save approximately \$60,000.00 annually by replacing these lights; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to submit applications is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:**


**SECTION 1.** That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all documents necessary to initiate the programs with PP&L and the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board to replace 810 streetlights, for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
