**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING  
A GRANT FROM THE WASHINGTON STATE  
DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY TO ASSIST  
THE CITY WITH WATER QUALITY AND SYSTEM  
CAPACITY OF OUR STORMWATER PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside is responsible for system maintenance, capacity, and water quality within its storm water system; and

**WHEREAS**, the Washington State Department of Ecology (WSDOE) notified city staff of a grant opportunity for stormwater phase II permittees. This grant will aid in addressing infrastructure needs in system capacity and improvement of water quality. Grant funds can be used to purchase equipment, program implementation, employee wages, etc; and

**WHEREAS**, the WSDOE has offered the City of Sunnyside a grant in the amount of \$95,000.00 to be used for the administration of the grant and operational needs and requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that the acceptance of this grant from the WSDOE is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:**


**SECTION 1.** That the City of Sunnyside City Council hereby accepts the grant from the WSDOE in the amount of \$95,000.00 for system maintenance, capacity, and water quality in our Stormwater System, and authorizes the City Manager to execute any and all documentation related to this grant.
