**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING AN
AGREEMENT WITH FERGUSON WATERWORKS TO
UPGRADE OUR AMR WATER METER READING SYSTEM
TO AN AMI WATER METER READING SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the City is tasked with the responsibility of operating and maintaining all water system infrastructure within the City limits; and

WHEREAS, Ferguson Waterworks has been the water meter supplier for the city for more than 15 years; and

WHEREAS, staff contacted Ferguson Waterworks to assess our current water meter reading system, which is considered an Automatic Meter Reading (AMR) system, to upgrade to an Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) system; and

WHEREAS, the current AMR system will be obsolete within the next year, so it's essential that the city make improvements to its system to ensure seamless water meter readings and with the least amount of interruption to the citizens; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of this project is \$123,817.00, which includes all materials and labor to install an AMI meter reading system that will serve the citizens of Sunnyside for the next 20 years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that these improvements are in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WAHSINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Sunnyside authorizes the City Manager to execute and agreement with Ferguson Waterworks to

upgrade our current water meter reading system to an AMI system, and is in accordance with the incentive offer which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and administer an agreement for and on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.



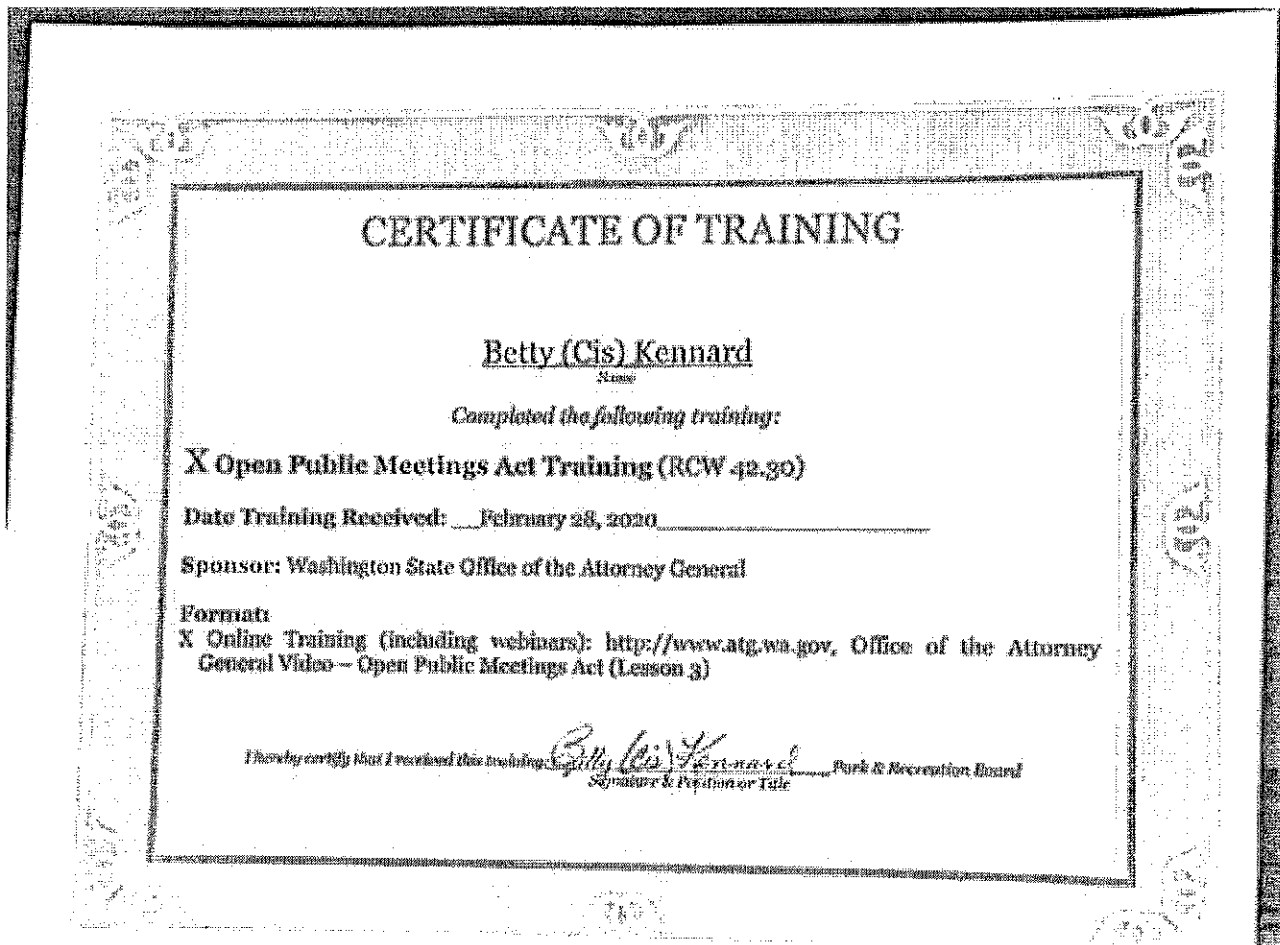
