

RESOLUTION 2020 - 23

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING A
BID AND AUTHORIZING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT
WITH COLUMBIA PUMPING & CONSTRUCTION, INC.
(11th Street, 6th to 9th Street Pipe Lining Project)**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside operates and maintains all sewer, water, and storm drain lines within the city limits; and

WHEREAS, the city staff has identified two problematic areas that require repairs to the sewer infrastructure. The first area is located on N. 11th Street, from Yakima Valley Highway to Yakima Avenue. The second section of piping is located in N. 6th Street adjacent to ACE Hardware and runs east across the ACE Hardware parking lot all the way to N. 9th Street; and

WHEREAS, the City solicited bids and received (2) bids to slip line for approximately 1,225' of 12" sewer main. The lowest bid submitted by a qualified bidder is in the amount of \$69,110.00, from Columbia Pumping & Construction Inc., of Pasco, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that acceptance of such bid and authorizing the City Manager to prepare and execute an agreement with Columbia Pumping & Construction Inc., for the construction of the 11th Street, 6th to 9th Street pipelining project is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the bid in the amount of \$69,110.00, not including applicable taxes, submitted by Columbia Pumping & Construction Inc., for the work on the 11th Street, 6th to 9th Street pipelining project in accordance with the bid which is attached as Exhibit "A", is hereby accepted; and the City Manager is hereby authorized to prepare, execute and administer an agreement for the construction of such work, all in accordance with plans and specifications for such project.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.



You must supply, at no charge, all needed construction water and an approved dumpsite for material removed from the lines in the cleaning portion of the project. You must provide large vehicle access to all affected manholes at no charge. Traffic control is included by use of signs and cones only. You must supply a reasonably secure laydown area at no charge. Pre- and post-lining video inspection is included. Anything not included is excluded. If Columbia is unable to perform scheduled work due to no fault of Columbia, a \$575.00 per hour standby charge will be assessed.
