**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, APPROVING
THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN CITY OF SUNNYSIDE
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN EVALUATION AND UPDATE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, in 1990, the State of Washington passed legislation commonly referred to as the Growth Management Act (GMA). The GMA established specific goals and requirements that all local comprehensive plans and development regulations are to achieve. The GMA, as amended, is found under Chapter 36.70A of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW); and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside is beginning the process of reviewing and updating as need the Sunnyside Comprehensive Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Plan Evaluation and Update Project will represent a broad and deliberate review of the City's comprehensive plan and development regulations. This review is also to provide an opportunity to review the effectiveness of the comprehensive plan; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside want to assure that public participation is encouraged and provided for during the review and update process; and,

WHEREAS, the Sunnyside Planning Commission has recommended a document titled "Public Participation Plan City of Sunnyside Comprehensive Plan Evaluation and Update Project" to assure public participation is encouraged for the comprehensive plan updated process; and

WHEREAS, the Sunnyside City County has review and discussed the Public Participation Plan City of Sunnyside Comprehensive Plan Evaluation and Update Project; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that approval of such plan is in the best interest of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote public participation in the comprehensive plan update process.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Public Participation Plan City of Sunnyside Comprehensive Plan Evaluation and Update Project attached to this resolution is adopted for assuring public participation in the comprehensive plan update process.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon as required by law.
