**WHEREAS**, Ron Stremmer owned and operated Sun Valley Electric in Sunnyside for 30 years and served as Sunnyside Reserve Police Officer from 1990 to 1994; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron Stremmer was appointed to the Sunnyside City Council on February 27, 2017, to complete an unexpired term and was then elected to a full term with nearly 60% of the vote on November 7, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Ron Stremmer actively served as Chair of Council's Public Safety Subcommittee, as a member of Council's Rules Subcommittee, as Council's representative to Sunnyside United/Unidos, and was elected by Council to serve as 2020-2021 Deputy Mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 4, 2021, Ron Stremmer retired from Council after demonstrating great devotion and leadership to Sunnyside throughout his years of business and public service,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside desires to express its appreciation to Ron Stremmer for his years of service to the Sunnyside City Council and the City of Sunnyside.


