**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE,
WASHINGTON, EXPRESSING CONCERNS FOR SECOND SUBSTITUTE HOUSE
BILL 1220 AMENDING STATE LAWS REGARDING AFFORDABLE HOUSING.**

WHEREAS, the State of Washington is considering Second Substitute House Bill (SSHB) 1220 to amend the Growth Management Act and Land use regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Association of Washington Cities has requested that Cities consider contacting legislators to express concerns with the local government planning preemptions in SSHB 1220; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Sections 3 and 4 of SSHB 1220 in its current form will significantly and potentially negatively impact the City of Sunnyside's efforts to update its Comprehensive Plan, zoning ordinances, and housing strategies.


**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Sunnyside, Washington, takes an official position in opposition to Sections 3 and 4 of SSHB 1220 in their present form and urges state legislators to preserve local flexibility in the siting of emergency shelters and housing, supportive housing, and other similar facilities


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
