

RESOLUTION 2021 - 25

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH HLA
ENGINEERING AND LAND SURVEYING TO DESIGN THE
PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, AND ENGINEERS ESTIMATE FOR THE
FRANKLIN COURT WATERMAIN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City is responsible to operate and maintain all water distribution infrastructure within the City limits of Sunnyside; and

WHEREAS, city staff has identified an undersized water main on Franklin Court that must be replaced with an 8" PVC main to allow for future water service connections, as well as satisfy fire flow demands; and

WHEREAS, city staff recommends that city council authorize the city manager to execute an agreement in the way of a task order (2021-05) with HLA Engineering to design plans, specifications, and engineers estimate to replace the existing water main on Franklin Court with a new 8" PVC main; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside City Council finds and determines that task order 2021-05 with HLA Engineering is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Task Order 2021-05 in the amount of \$36,300.00, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and administer any and all documentation related to the Franklin Court WATERMAIN Improvement project on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.



EXHIBIT A

TASK ORDER NO. 2021-05

REGARDING GENERAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF SUNNYSIDE

AND

HLA ENGINEERING AND LAND SURVEYING, INC. (HLA)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Franklin Court Watermain Improvements

The City of Sunnyside (CITY) desires to construct a new 8-inch watermain loop in Franklin Court and connect 13 existing water services to enhance water availability and fire flow. The existing residential homes in Franklin Court are currently served from one 2-inch service line offering no fire protection. The improvements will reduce operation and maintenance costs, increase reliability, and provide capacity needed for the existing development.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

At the direction of the CITY, HLA shall provide professional engineering services for the Franklin Court Watermain Improvements project. HLA services shall include the following:

1.0 Engineering Design, Plans, Specifications, and Estimate

- 1.1 Perform field topographic survey of the project area as required to complete design, plans, and specifications for the improvements.
- 1.2 Review topographic survey data and prepare preliminary site layout plans for review with CITY.
- 1.3 Conduct site visit with CITY to review proposed preliminary site layout. Perform field investigations necessary to design the identified improvements.
- 1.4 Coordinate design with utility companies; meet with utility company representatives on site to review proposed improvements.
- 1.5 Prepare preliminary design plans and specifications for review and discussion with CITY staff. Plans will be distributed electronically for review. Meet with CITY staff to review and discuss preliminary plans.
- 1.6 Incorporate CITY review comments and prepare final draft plans, specifications, and estimate for review and approval by CITY.
- 1.7 Incorporate CITY review comments and prepare final design plans, specifications, and estimate for publicly bid improvements, as authorized by the CITY.

2.0 Bidding and Services During Construction

It is anticipated bidding and services during construction will be added as a supplement or separate Task Order at the time the CITY decides to move forward to construction.

3.0 Additional Services

- 3.1 Provide professional engineering services for additional work requested by the CITY that is not included in this Task Order.

EXHIBIT A

3.0 Additional Services

Any additional work requested by the CITY that is not included in this Task Order shall be authorized by the CITY and agreed upon by HLA in writing prior to proceeding with services. HLA shall perform the additional services as directed/authorized by the CITY on a time-spent basis at the hourly billing rates included in our General Agreement, plus reimbursement for direct non-salary expenses such as laboratory testing, printing expenses, vehicle mileage, out-of-town travel costs, and outside consultants.
