

ORDINANCE 2021 - 17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 2.02 OF THE SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE, PERTAINING TO SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 35A.13 of the Revised Code of Washington, the City Council is charged with the legislative authority of the City of Sunnyside; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.02 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code governs all fees and charges within the city; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Chapter 2.02 should be amended to include increased Garbage rates; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that adoption of these amendments is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2.02 SMC is amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Except as amended herein, Title 2 SMC shall remain unchanged.

Section 3. That the utility rates adopted herein shall apply to the billing issued on January 31, 2022 and all subsequent billings.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after passage, approval and publication as required by law, and


