Proclamation

WHEREAS, the Agriculture Council of America is an organization uniquely composed of leaders in the agriculture, food and fiber communities dedicated to increasing public awareness of agriculture's vital role in our society and has since 1973, sponsored a National Ag Day program; and,

WHEREAS, The President of United States recently issued Presidential Proclamation 10158 proclaiming National Agriculture Day, in which he called upon the people of the United States to "...recognize the unique and irreplaceable value that farmers, ranchers, foresters, farmworkers, and other agricultural stewards have contributed to our Nation's past and present": and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has since its inception been an agricultural-based farm community, and our farmers contribute to the over 40 commercial crops grown in Yakima Valley, including asparagus, hops, corn, wheat, peppers, cherries, peaches, mint, grapes, and apples: and,

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside wishes to join with the President and Congressman Dan Newhouse of the 4th Congressional district in expressing our sincere appreciation for the farmers and ranchers of our community and to publicly thank them for their contributions.

NOW THEREFORE, I, James A. Restucci, Deputy Mayor of the City of Sunnyside, Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Washington and on behalf of the City Council do hereby proclaim, today, March 28, 2022 as **National Agriculture Day** in the City of Sunnyside.
