

ORDINANCE 2022 - 10

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,
REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 2.02.020 OF THE
SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously enacted Section 2.02.020 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code entitled Schedule of Fees and Charges through ordinance of the Sunnyside City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City must update the schedule from time to time as necessary for the operation of City services; and

WHEREAS, the fees and charges for Parks and Recreation need to be added to the schedule in accordance with Chapter 12.06 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 2.02.020 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code entitled "Schedule of Fees and Charges" is repealed and is hereby replaced upon adoption and incorporation of Exhibit A "Schedule of Fees and Charges", attached hereto.


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective five days after passage, approval and publication as required by law.


