

ORDINANCE 2023 - 01

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,  
REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 2.02.020 OF THE  
SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside has previously enacted Section 2.02.020 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code entitled Schedule of Fees and Charges through ordinance of the Sunnyside City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must update the schedule from time to time as necessary for the operation of City services; and

**WHEREAS**, the fees and charges for fiscal year 2023 must be updated to reflect the costs of doing business in order to adequately provide for sustainable services and the health and safety of the residents and businesses in the City of Sunnyside;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That the applicable fees listed in Section 2.02.020 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code entitled "Schedule of Fees and Charges" are repealed and hereby replaced upon adoption and incorporation of Exhibit A "Schedule of Fees and Charges", attached hereto.

**SECTION 2.** This Ordinance shall be effective five days after passage, approval and publication as required by law.
