

ORDINANCE 2023 - 21

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING CHAPTER 10.08.045 OF THE SUNNYSIDE MUNICIPAL CODE
RESTRICTED PARKING**

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously enacted Chapter 10.08.045 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code entitled Restricted Parking through ordinance of the Sunnyside City Council; and

WHEREAS, the current parking spots designated for City staff parking at the Fire Station are no longer usable or desired upon the current orientation of the Fire Station after the expansion/remodel; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has decided that amending the ordinance will allow for more appropriate use for staff during department events, training, and emergency responses;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter is amended as set forth in **EXHIBIT A** attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. Except as amended herein, Chapter 10.08.045 shall remain unchanged.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after passage, approval and publication as required by law.

EXHIBIT A

Proposed Amended Verbiage

10.08.045 Restricted parking.

The following described parking spaces are established as restricted parking zones and shall be reserved for parking official City vehicles only, and it shall be unlawful for any nonauthorized person or vehicle to utilize said spaces:

~~A. The three parking spaces adjacent to the fire station administrative offices on the west side of Eighth Street between Edison Avenue and Franklin Avenue; and~~

The first four parking spaces north of the alley between Edison Avenue and Franklin Avenue, on the west side of Eighth Street; and

B. The parking spaces along the alley between Edison Avenue and Decatur Avenue, from Eighth Street to Ninth Street, shall be reserved and restricted to official City vehicles and vehicles of City employees.
