**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, DECLARING  
CERTAIN EQUIPMENT SURPLUS TO THE USES AND NEEDS OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE AND AUTHORIZING DISPOSITION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sunnyside Public Works Department maintains the vehicle fleet for all City departments; and

**WHEREAS**, the fleet has an Ambulance (Vehicle ID 037,

VIN: 1FDXE45P16DB15328) that has come to the end of its useful life as it relates to the operations of the city; and

**WHEREAS**, once the ambulance has been declared surplus, city staff will take appropriate steps to fairly dispose of the ambulance in accordance with state and local laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that the ambulance listed no longer meet the needs of the City of Sunnyside, and should be declared surplus, with disposition authorized by any means deemed appropriate under state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines that such declaration and disposition of property is in the best interests of residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare.


**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That the ambulance is hereby declared to be surplus to the uses and needs of the City of Sunnyside.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to dispose of such equipment by any means allowable pursuant to state law and Chapter 3.12 of the Sunnyside Municipal Code.


**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.
