**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING
THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A FUNDING APPLICATION TO
THE WASHINGTON STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT BOARD
FOR PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) has a call for funding applications to design and construct complete street elements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside passed a Complete Streets Policy, Chapter 12.07 SMC, and is eligible to apply for funding;

WHEREAS, submission of an application is consistent with the City's 6-Year Transportation Improvement Plan;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that authorizing the City Manager to submit a funding application, is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside and will promote the general health, safety and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Sunnyside hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit a funding application, draft attached hereto as Exhibits "A", and act on behalf of the City of Sunnyside.


SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage, approval and signatures hereon in accordance with law.

The City has completed the Self-Evaluation step of the ADA Transition Plan and has inventoried all existing ADA routes within the City's right of way including sidewalks, curb ramps, cross walks, push buttons and signals, rail road crossings, and walking paths. The immediate need for the community is to replace non-ADA compliant ramps and install cross walks where none exist or are non-compliant. The non-compliant ADA ramps are generally on walking routes to schools or within the downtown corridors where walkability and connectivity is important.

What complete streets elements and modal solutions are being used?

The project will replace non compliant ADA ramps and replace non compliant cross walk markings and/or add crosswalk markings where non exist.
